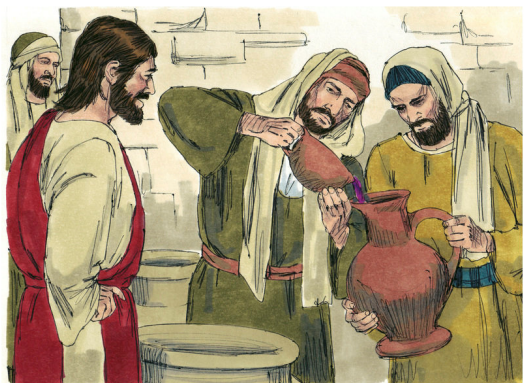

Scripture Reflection – 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Jesus...revealed his glory, & his disciples began to believe in him" (John 2:11)

Jesus' first miracle was impressive – he turned water into wine. Because it happened at a marriage celebration, you might consider this a special wedding gift for the happy couple. But it was also a miracle performed so that his disciples would see his glory and "believe in him" (John 2:11).

John tells us that this was the first sign that Jesus performed. Then he goes on to recount six more signs, each of which is meant to deepen his disciples' faith – and ours as well. Each sign tells us that when we place our faith in him, he sets us on a path of renewal. He takes our plain, everyday 'water' and turns it into choice 'wine'.

What do the other signs tell us? That Jesus' words have the power to heal us (John 4:46-54, 6:1-9). That he wants to feed us with his Living Bread and calm the storms and anxieties in our hearts (6:1-21). That he wants to open our eyes to see him as the Lord who loves us (9:1-7, 35-39). That he wants to raise us from our "tombs" of sin, doubt and unbelief (11:1-44). All of these stories point to God's work of restoring and renewing what is lacking. They tell us that God wants to restore in us the joy of worship and to become for us the source of all blessing.

Feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul the Apostle

Friday's feast celebrates God's triumph, even in the most unlikely circumstances. Before Saint Paul meets the risen Lord on the road to Damascus, he is Saul, dedicated to viciously persecuting the followers of Jesus Christ. Imagine yourself among those early Christians, and hearing that Saul, one of the most feared enemies of your community, has encountered the Lord and changed his life entirely to serve him from then on. Although certainly astonishing, the conversion of Saint Paul is also deeply inspiring, for it tells us that God does not hold our mistakes against us, but rather calls us to turn our minds and hearts to follow his Son instead. The conversion of Saint Paul is proof that no one is too far beyond the call of the Lord to follow, and that in Christ, change for the better is always possible.
