**The Easter Vigil - climax of the Sacred Paschal Triduum**  
*The Easter Vigil is not an ordinary Saturday evening Mass. It begins after dark at 8:00 pm.* The Mass hour shows its unique character as the greatest celebration in the Church year.

“Shattering the darkness, the great Paschal candle is lit with the Easter fire, five wax nails of incense are imbedded, and it becomes the symbol of the crucified Christ. The Paschal Mystery, already celebrated in various ways since the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, is clearly and joyfully announced from the very beginning of the Vigil liturgy. It is in the light of the Paschal candle that the liturgy continues to unfold. The Easter Vigil is the most beautiful of all liturgies. Ranking highest among the celebrations of the liturgical year, it should rank highest in the spiritual life of the parish community – not a small task in places where Christmas is considered the high point.” (LTP – 2016)

### Easter Season

**(April 22nd – June 8th)**

Having lived through the mystery and power of Holy Week, we now enter the weeks of Easter Time with joy. Easter is not a one day affair: it is a transformation that we carry forward into our lives.

This joy of knowing Jesus Christ call us to witness to His Resurrection. Like the disciples who were His companions in life, we are propelled forward into the world as we realize the magnitude of what He has done and have His Spirit breathed out upon us anew.

Pope Francis calls us to that Alleluia people of evangelizers:

“Evangelization with joy becomes beauty in the liturgy, as part of our daily concern to spread goodness. The Church evangelizes and is herself evangelized through the beauty of the liturgy, which is both a celebration of the task of evangelization and the source of her renewed self-giving. (EG, 24).”

This is the season to invite people into a more “full, conscious and active participation” (CSL, 7) in the Mass, not only for their own spiritual nourishment but so that when others come to pray within our Body, they feel the vibrant presence of the love of God. We should not have to tell them that we are and Easter people; it should radiate powerfully in our midst. Alleluia is our song!
