Second Sunday of Lent

"If you wish, I will make three tents." (Matthew 17:4)

Today's Gospel is one of great mystery: the Transfiguration. Moses and Elijah appear next to Jesus, who himself is completely transfigured, radiating pure light. Imagine yourself there... the sight must have been out of this world! In the face of all this glory, Peter's first reaction is to set up three dwellings, offering them worldly comfort. How often is God right in front of us, showing us his divinity and his plan for our life, and we focus on logistics and worldly preoccupations?

As a matter of fact, today during Mass, we will witness one of the greatest miracles of all time: bread and wine becoming Jesus' body and blood. The Eucharist is the sacrament where we get a glimpse of God's glory and power. For a moment, heaven and earth meet. As we witness this miracle today, where will our heart and mind be? Will we be checking the time, or revelling in God's glory? Will we be thinking about the things we need to do this week, or listening to God speak to our heart? God's words to the disciples are a wakeup call: "Get up and do not be afraid." They prompt us to refocus on what's important: not worldly considerations, but an attentive ear and an open heart to his ever-living word, calling us to be examples of heaven here on earth.

Lent: Forty Days and Fasting

Forty is a number which comes up often in the Scripture and it means "for a sufficient time". When Lent began to be a more extended period of time, it first lasted forty days. But since Sundays have always been excluded as fast days (because that is the day of the Lord, the day of resurrection), that meant Lent consisted of fewer than forty days.

During a time when the Church emphasized the sinfulness and unworthiness of the baptized, Lent was extended back to the Wednesday before the First Sunday of Lent in order to have forty fast days (the origin of Ash Wednesday). We cannot explain Lent only in terms of fasting: Lent is truly a period of conversion which culminates in the renewal of baptismal promises at the Easter Vigil or Easter Sunday Mass. *Living Liturgy*"
