

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

• Deuteronomy 18:15-20 • Psalm 95 • 1 Corinthians 7:32-35 • Mark 1:21-28 •

When I moved to the Maritimes, I planned to spend one of my first Sundays relaxing on a beach after Mass. However, not knowing where such a beach was, I sat in my parked car looking at a map. Thunk! Someone leaving Mass had backed into my vehicle. "No problem," I thought. "I'm at church, this process will be painless." I had had a previous car mishap in a secular context which turned into quite an ordeal. My expectations of ease, and that adversity would not reach into the church parking lot were false – our fallen humanity follows us everywhere. Thankfully our faith ought not depend on anyone or anything apart from Jesus. No wickedness can snatch us from either his gaze or his hand; someone's sins or poor choices do not affect that.

In today's Gospel we hear how there was "in their synagogue, a man with an unclean spirit" who was crying out. Evil manifested itself in the holy place of God. And Jesus handled it.

When we experience disappointing behaviour amongst the faithful or are even faced with larger scandals involving those in leadership, we need not lose our faith in Jesus. Such circumstances do not reflect Jesus' authenticity, nor do they question his authority. Instead, we turn to the One who silences the voice of evil and casts it out.
